Global Goal / longterm vision

Qualitative Goal:

convergence around the ideas of :

.....to reduce vulnerability, increase resilience and adaptive capacity, to enable climate resilient sustainable development

Quantitative Goal:

determined by mitigation ambition, adaptation needs and costs; Assessment of adequacy of support



Commitments

- All Parties need to undertake adaptation action!
- Flexibility on what countries do
 - national adaptation planning process
 - Cooperation (info sharing, strengthening institutions
 - Communication tools (new vehicle vs existing vehicle)
 - how often to communicate
